



Dear Parents:

The two-year-old program is designed for children turning two on or before September 1, 2024. The children attend class on Monday and Tuesday from 9:00-11:15 a.m.

Fee schedule: \$85.00 registration fee (non-refundable)
Two-day program - \$1980.00 per year, (\$220.00 per month)

To enroll your child you must return:

- the enrollment or reenrollment application
- registration fee (non-refundable)
- one month's security deposit (non-refundable after August 1; to be applied to tuition in May 2025)

In-House Registration Day for children *currently* enrolled, and/or their siblings, is Tuesday, January 9, 2024 at 12:00 a.m.

We will not accept registration packets prior to this date.

On In-House Registration Day:

- Bring your application and payment together in the enclosed envelope. You may combine both fees in one check.
- Mark your child's name, the desired class, and your payment method on the outside of the envelope.
- Please wait in line outside red doors of the Fellowship Hall (near the playground).
- We will collect your envelope and number them as they are received. Each twos class has a maximum of 12 students, the threes class has a maximum of 15 students, and the fours class has a maximum of 18 students.
- Only once we receive your application with full payment, will your child be enrolled. You will receive all other necessary forms at that time.

New students may register beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 11, 2024.

- You may enroll in person at the Preschool or you may mail in your registration.
- Only once we receive your application with full payment, will your child be enrolled. You will receive all other necessary forms at that time.

We accept cash, checks, and Zelle for payments. If you choose to use Zelle, please use dgill2@verizon.net as the payment account.

Registration is accepted on a space-available basis.
