Virtue of the Month - EMPATHY

Empathy is the capacity for experiencing as one's own the feeling of another, walking a mile in someone else's shoes. It's very closely related to compassion. Children learn about empathy as they relate to the feelings of others. We can foster the feeling of empathy by asking a child how he or she would feel about things that they see happen to their friends, if that same thing happened to him or her.
